Daylight Savings Time Spring 2009

Daylight Savings Time (DST) begins in March or April in many countries around the world. In all places where DST is observed clocks on the 3M Wireless Communication System Model XT-1 will have the incorrect time, which may cause issues if you use the Store Closed Message feature, as it may play at an incorrect time.

In order to correct this issue you can:

1. If the system is networked, and you can log on to the base station, you can remotely update the time
2. Call 1-800-328-0033 and have one of our agents talk you through updating the Model XT-1 Base Station time.
3. Follow the procedure below and update the Base Station time.

Set System Date and Time

Perform the following procedure to set the system time and date.

1. From the Run mode menu, press and hold Mode.
2. While continuing to hold Mode, enter your user passcode.
3. Release Mode. The display will show the user name and ID number (e.g., User1 ID = 1)
Notes: The default user password is 1234.
4. Change the date and time values for **06 Set Time & Date** in the **Time and Date** fields as required. Use the arrows to scroll from one field to the next and type new values over the existing data in the formats shown in parentheses:
 - HH = Hours (01 to 24, e.g., 6:00 pm is 18)
